1 Group Signing of the UK Steel Charter

The Mayor and Members of the Business Advisory Board signed the UK Steel Charter, acknowledging the heritage of South Yorkshire and demonstrating continued support for the steel industry.

3 Welcome and Apologies

The Co-Chairs welcomed all to the meeting and apologies were noted as above.

4 Minutes and Actions of the Previous Meeting

Members approved the minutes of the 23rd January meeting.

5 Presentation - a Global Leader in Steel Production and Engineering

The Board received a presentation from Gary Nutter of Forgemasters which covered company background, defence outputs and recapitalisation.

6 Presentation - Maximising Strategic Support for the Steel Industry

Gareth Stace of UK Steel presented an item on Maximising Support for the Steel Industry.

The steel industry employed nearly 40,000 people in the UK. It was noted that these jobs were highly skilled and well paid, and in areas of the country that the government had committed to levelling up. The industry was also dedicated to developing home-grown skills and knowledge, employing 600 apprentices throughout the UK with plans to increase this by taking on 200 more every year.

Board members were keen to understand how we could communicate the key messages more widely.

RECOMMENDATION: UK Steel to prepare a briefing for South Yorkshire MPs.

7 Developing Strong SY Communications to Attract Inward Investment -Recap, Next Steps and UKREiiF

Rachel Clark updated Members on the plans for UKREiiF ahead of the event which would be held in Leeds between $21^{st} - 23^{rd}$ May. The MCA and four local authorities were collaborating in order to promote a united South Yorkshire approach, building on the success of the previous year.

Key discussion points:

BAB members indicated their support for being part of UKREiFF and will

- liaise directly with Rachel Clark. Keen to explore whether we can identify a target list of UKREiFF attendees.
- BAB members also set out support for pulling together wider programme of support to new inward investors, including supply chain mapping and development tools (borrowing thinking from other areas)
- BAB members pressed MCA to develop (and be engaged on) more thinking around:
 - How we communicate the pipeline of inward investors and build welcoming package
 - Develop and communicate a clearer focus on the sectors and capabilities of businesses we're looking to attract.
 - How we plug inward investors into deep sector knowledge / partnerships
