2. SMART Investment:


- Progress securing resources and investment required for future years of Connected by Water (2.1)

Overview of 2023 Proposed Plan Updates



We are bringing the draft plan update for comment and support. This is an opportunity to input ahead of the plan being republished in January.

Proposed Changes to Plan Text:

- Minor tweaks to text across the plan to reflect being in delivery phase and updates to case studies
- Updates to theme introductions to reflect work completed in 2022 which will now become business as usual and to incorporate response to the consultation
- Revision of Appendix 1 based on updated South Yorkshire programme
- Addition of an Appendix 2 to record completed/removed actions


Proposed Changes to Plan Actions:

- Theme Task & Finish Groups reviewing list of actions in each theme for update in 2023 plan;
 - 7% of actions have been completed
 - 55% of actions are being updated (including 12% of actions where Step 1 has been completed and Step 2 is being defined)
 - 38% of actions are remaining the same as the 2022 plan

- The updated plan will be uploaded to the Connected by Water website
