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Executive Summary

This report requests the approval/ endorsement to progress 7 schemes subject to the conditions set out in the Assurance Summaries.

What does this mean for businesses, people and places in South Yorkshire?

This report is seeking approval to progress business cases and enter into contract for a number of investment proposals which will support the MCA's aspirations.

Recommendations

The Board consider and approve:

1. Progression of 'T0014/1 – West of Doncaster Active Travel (Edlington)' Full Business Case (FBC) to approval and award of £0.38m grant from Transforming Cities Fund (TCF) to Doncaster Metropolitan Borough Council (DMBC) subject to the conditions set out in the Assurance Summary attached at Appendix A1;

- 2. Progression of 'T0017/3 Bennethorpe to Hallgate' FBC to approval and award of £1.26m grant from TCF to DMBC subject to the conditions set out in the Assurance Summary attached at Appendix A2;
- 3. Approval of 'MSF0005 Active Travel Crossings' Business Justification Case (BJC) and award of £1m grant from Mayors Sustainability Fund (MSF) to South Yorkshire Mayoral Combined Authority (SYMCA), subject to the conditions set out in the Assurance Summary attached at Appendix B1;
- 4. Progression of 'CRSTS08/01 Darton Active Travel Route' Strategic Business Case (SBC) to Outline Business Case (OBC) and release of development costs of £0.16m against scheme costs of £1m from City Region Sustainable Transport Settlement (CRSTS) to Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council (BMBC), subject to the conditions set out in the Assurance Summary attached at Appendix C1:
- 5. Progression of 'CRSTS05/01 Wombwell to Worsborough TPT Link' SBC to OBC and release of development costs of £0.15m against scheme costs of £1.1m from CRSTS to BMBC, subject to the conditions set out in the Assurance Summary attached at Appendix C2;
- 6. Delegated authority be given to the Head of Paid Service in consultation with the Section 73 and Monitoring Officer to enter into Legal agreements for the schemes covered above.

Progression of 'CRSTS11 A61 Chesterfield Road' to MCA for approval of progression from SBC to OBC and release of development costs of £0.25m against scheme costs of £10m from CRSTS to Sheffield City Council (SCC), subject to the conditions set out in the Assurance Summary attached at Appendix C3:
- 8. Progression of 'CRSTS49 Park & Ride Penistone Rail Station' to MCA for approval of progression from SBC to OBC and release of development costs of £0.75m against scheme costs of £4m from CRSTS to SYMCA, subject to the conditions set out in the Assurance Summary attached at Appendix C4.

1. Background

1.1 This report seeks approval for the progression of 7 schemes that will be resourced from previously committed Transforming Cities Fund (TCF), City Region Sustainable Travel Settlements (CRSYS) and Mayor's Sustainable Fund (MSF) grant funding.

1.2 Progression of schemes to full approval and award of funding

The paper is seeking progression to full approval and award of funding for 2 projects. The schemes are detailed in Appendix A. The total amount of funding requested is £1.64m and will be funded from TCF. The projects are located within Doncaster.

Full details of the schemes and risks are included in Appendix A1 and A2.

1.3 Approval of business justification case and award of funding

The paper is seeking approval of 1 scheme and award of funding. The scheme is detailed in Appendix B. The total amount of funding requested is £1m and will be funded from MSF. The project is located across South Yorkshire.

Full details of the schemes and risks are included in Appendix B1

1.4 Progression of schemes from strategic business case to outline business case with release of development costs

The paper is seeking approval of progression of 2 schemes and endorsement to MCA Board for approval of 2 schemes progressing from SBC to OBC and the release of development funding. The schemes are detailed in Appendix C. The amount of funding requested is £1.36m against scheme costs of £16.7m and will be funded from CRSTS. One scheme is located in Sheffield, 2 are located in Barnsley and one is relation to Penistone Rail Station which is being delivered by SYMCA.

Full details of the schemes and risks are included in Appendix C1, C2, C3 and C4.

2. Options Considered and Recommended Proposal

4.1 Subject to the approval of the recommendations, the Head of Paid Service in consultation with the Section 73 Officer and Monitoring Officer will progress to enter into legal agreements with the promoter.

- 5.1 The projects presented for endorsement today are profiled to draw down funding as follows:
 - £1.35m from the City Region Sustainable Transport Fund total allocation of £496.5m;
 - £1.64m from the Transforming Cities Fund total allocation of £166.3m;
 - £1m from the Mayors Sustainable Transport Fund total allocation of £12m.

6. Legal Implications and Advice

- 6.1 The legal implications of the projects have been fully considered by a representative of the Monitoring Officer and included in the recommendations agreed within the Assurance Summaries as presented in the Appendices.
