Appendix A1 provides a summary of the project assurance and any suggested conditions of award.

This investment is for £0.38M from Transforming Cities Fund (TCF) to Doncaster Metropolitan Borough Council (RMBC) towards total project costs of £0.38m.

The project has delivered an off-road cycle route which has connected existing and future planned residential neighbourhoods, to employment opportunities within Warmsworth. The facilities will also provide a route towards the proposed Balby scheme providing connections towards Doncaster town Centre.



A.2 T0017/3 Bennethorpe to Hallgate (DMBC)

Appendix A2 provides a summary of the project assurance and any suggested conditions of award.

This investment is for £1.26m from TCF towards total project costs of £1.26m.

The scheme will provide off road cycle facilities running from the South Parade / Thorne Road junction to the Bennethorpe / Roman Road junction. Between the South Parade / Thorne Road junction and proposed new toucan crossing the scheme provides 2m wide off road cycleways along each side of the carriageway. Between the toucan crossing and Bennethorpe / Roman Road junction the scheme provides a 3m wide off road bi-directional cycleway alongside the northern side of the carriageway.

The bi-directional section and toucan crossing allow connectivity with the proposed new Unity cycle scheme package, in order to take cyclists safely across the carriageway and into the town centre.


