B.1 MSF0005 – Active Travel Crossings

Appendix B1 provides a summary of the project assurance and any suggested conditions of award.

This investment is for £1.0m from Mayor's Sustainable Transport Fund (MSTF) to SYMCA towards total project costs of £1m.

The project will deliver controlled crossings, refuges and other associated traffic calming measures in prioritised areas across South Yorkshire to enhance access to local natural areas in a safe and measured way.

The Benefits and Outcomes –

The project will deliver the following outputs

- Barnsley: 1 x Pegasus crossing
- Doncaster: 2 x pelican crossings, 1 x toucan crossing
- Rotherham: 2 x puffin crossing, amendments to road and footway, removal of bus shelter
- Sheffield: various improvements including traffic calming measures, 7 x pedestrian refuges, 5 x traffic islands, 3 x footways, 3 x disabled parking bays

The project aligns with Strategic Economic Plan (SEP) and the Renewal Action Plan (RAP).
