

Overview

This Quarter:

The Health Led Trial commenced in May 2018, and is being delivered by South Yorkshire Housing Association (secured through a competitive tendered process). The delivery commenced seven months after the trial was expected to start, and is due to conclude on 31st October 2020.

Consequently, the referral window for participants on the trial was reduced from 18 months to 11 months. However, following appeals made by Sheffield City Region, the Work and Health Unit accepted that the delays were due to circumstances beyond the control of Sheffield City Region or South Yorkshire Housing Association, and agreed to extend the referral window, and thus the project as a whole, by seven months, extending the trial end date to 31st October 2020. The Work and Health Unit also agreed to provide additional funding for the extra seven months.

The Health Led Trial commenced in May 2018, seven months after the trial was expected to start.

Starts on the trial remains behind profile. Various issues, such as Research Ethics Committee (REC) approval (requiring central approval for all paperwork, communications and marketing materials that may be customer facing) have led to delays in the rolling out planned marketing activities, with some planned activities being held up by months. A relative lack of buy in from MSK teams across South Yorkshire and Bassetlaw has also lead to fewer referrals than anticipated. As such, the trial is not expected to hit the contract target of 3,600 starts.

Job Starts and Job Sustainments, however, have been very positive, with both in advance of profile, with South Yorkshire Housing Association expressing strong confidence in achieving the contracted targets.
