

Appendix B – Progression of Strategic Business Case to Outline Business Case and release of development costs

B.1 CRSTS47 Park and Ride Coinsbrough Rail Station

Appendix B1 provides a summary of the project assurance and any suggested conditions of award.

Conisbrough Station is a railway station located approximately 8km southwest of Doncaster and connects the town to Doncaster and Sheffield. The station currently has an existing small car park which pre-Covid was full to capacity on a typical weekday, causing delays and drivers struggling to find alternative locations for parking. This scheme aims to address these issues and also encourage travel to the station by alternative and sustainable travel modes to improve accessibility and connectivity for residents within the surrounding area.

The scheme includes an extension to the current car park to increase the number of car parking spaces available for rail users. Alongside this, a number of Electric Vehicle (EV) charging points will be installed to facilitate the use of EV's at the station. Improved pedestrian and cycling infrastructure will also be provided to improve access to the station for users travelling by sustainable travel modes, including a cycleway, pedestrian footpath improvements and secure cycle storage facilities. Lighting, CCTV and wayfinding will also be installed throughout the station gateway area.

This scheme provides a set of interventions that will enhance rail transport accessibility and connectivity for the local area.
