1. Introduction

- **1.1** Bus travel makes up the majority of public transport journeys that are made in South Yorkshire. It also accounts for over 60% of SYPTE's revenue expenditure.
- **1.2** The current position with regard to funding and governance has developed over a number of years and an understanding of the background is useful to help inform discussion on the future shape of bus services in South Yorkshire.

2. Proposal and justification

- **2.1** SYPTE has pursued a policy of Bus Partnerships as the mechanism for overseeing the delivery of bus services in South Yorkshire, following a decision taken by the (then) Integrated Transport Authority (ITA) in 2012.
- **2.2 Appendix 1** provides a summary of the background to the decision to pursue Bus Partnerships, the current structure, activities which are undertaken, and additional opportunities offered through the Bus Services Act.
- **2.3 Appendix 2** provides an overview of SYPTE's current budget, the key areas of expenditure, along with background on the principles that are used to allocate funding.
